WINEMAKER NOTES

Lazy River Vineyard lies 300-500 feet in elevation, on the steep south facing slope of Mt. Richmond in the Northwest Willamette Valley, in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. Soils include marine sediment and volcanic Jory. Lazy River is in a cooler location, nearly touching the foothills of the Coast Range.

TASTING NOTES

A beautiful ruby red in color, the Lazy River Vineyard Pinot Noir is a powerful and vibrant wine. It delights the senses with expressive aromas of rose hips, blueberries, white pepper and violets. The luscious palate shows savory notes, intertwined with intense flavors of blackberry compote and plum preserves. Long, velvety tannins enhance the wonderful dark fruits, leading to a long, lingering finish with focus and depth.
