## 2019 LAZY RIVER VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

### *Yamhill-Carlton AVA*

#### WINEMAKER NOTES

Lazy River Vineyard lies 300-500 feet in elevation, on the steep south facing slope of Mt. Richmond in the Northwest Willamette Valley, in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. Soils include marine sediment and volcanic Jory. Lazy River is in a cooler location, nearly touching the foothills of the Coast Range.

#### TASTING NOTES

A beautiful crimson in color, the Lazy River Vineyard Pinot Noir is a soft and gracious wine. It delights the senses with expressive aromas of Bing cherry and orange peel. The luscious palate shows savory notes of bergamot tea intertwined with intense flavors of red plum compote and raspberry preserves. Long, velvety tannins enhance the wonderful red fruit, leading to a lingering finish with focus and depth.
