Temperance Hill is a 100 acre vineyard located in the Eola-Amity Hills in the Willamette Valley. Temperance Hill is a cool site with an elevation range of 660 to 860 feet. Grapes are planted on many different slopes with various exposures in Nekia, Rittner and Jory soils. Temperance Hill's original vines date back to 1981.
